<b>Verbs</b>	<b>that ...</b>
announce	<i>they announced that they would be taking part</i>
complain	<i>they complained that the service was bad</i>
concede	<i>he conceded that she was right</i>
conclude	<i>the jury concluded that the defendant was innocent</i>
confirm	<i>they confirmed that he was not guilty</i>
emphasize	<i>she emphasized that the matter was urgent</i>
estimate	<i>they estimated that it would take a month</i>
explain	<i>he explained that it was wrong</i>
mention	<i>she mentioned that she was sick</i>
point out	<i>we pointed out that it was not our fault</i>
predict	<i>they predicted that the film would be a success</i>
remark	<i>he remarked that the sales had increased</i>
repeat	<i>I repeated that it was wrong</i>
say	<i>You said that you were right</i>
state	<i>he stated that we were making a mistake</i>
stress	<i>he stressed that we had to do it</i>

assure	<i>I assure you that there is nothing to worry about</i>
reassure	<i>he reassured her that the drugs had no side effects</i>

<b>Verbs</b>	<b>To-Infinitive</b>
offer	<i>they offered to help</i>
refuse	<i>they refused to help</i>

<b>Verbs</b>	<b>OBJ + To-Infinitive</b>
beg	<i>I begged him to stop</i>
encourage	<i>they encouraged him to take the money</i>
instruct	<i>they instructed him to take the money</i>
invite	<i>she invited me to go with her</i>
order	<i>she ordered me to go out</i>
persuade	<i>she persuaded me to come</i>

<b>Verbs</b>	<b>Dependent preposition + gerund</b>
accuse	<i>she accused him of deception</i>
apologize	<i>I apologized for arriving late</i>
argue	<i>they argued against reinstating him</i>
blame	<i>he blamed them for doing it</i>
confess	<i>he confess to doing it</i>
congratulate	<i>he congratulated me on passing the test</i>
consent	<i>she consented to being interviewed</i>
discourage	<i>they discouraged him from taking part</i>
dissuade	<i>they dissuaded him from taking part</i>
forgive	<i>they forgave him for doing it</i>
object	<i>she objected to being photographed</i>
praise	<i>they praised him for winning the prize</i>
protest	<i>they protested against firing him</i>
speak	<i>she spoke of reporting him</i>
tell off	<i>he told me off for singing</i>
thank	<i>she thanked me for turning up</i>
